Directions to the KAI-id LLC offices:

From the North:

Take the Maine Turnpike to exit 52 (Falmouth Spur) and head south on Route One, after ½ mile (and passing through 3 traffic lights) Falmouth Station is on your right. Pull into the parking lot and drive around the back of the building. The glass door ¾ of the way down the building is our office entrance. Go up the stairs and our office is the first door on the left.

From the South:

Take the Maine Turnpike to exit 52 and follow the directions from the North or take Route 295 to exit 9 and head North on Route 1 after 2.7 miles look for Falmouth Station on the left. Pull into the parking lot and drive around the back of the building. The glass door ¾ of the way down the building is our office entrance. Go up the stairs and our office is the first door on the left.
